A small but vocal group of film fanatics discussed Lincoln at our Nov. 25 film meetup. Although all agreed the acting, (especially Daniel Day Lewis), cinematography, production, etc. were superb, the expository style restricted a more expansive engaging experience. Rather than "Lincoln" which suggests a deeper study of the man, "The "13th Amendment" is a more appropriate title.

On a scale of 1 to 5 (5 is the highest), one 4, two 3s, and a 3.5 meant a mediocre 3.3 for the film. We did have an absentee vote of 5 which skewed the result to 3.7
